FOLLOWING JESUS

The foundation of the Christian experience is our relationship with Jesus. Whether we are beginning our discovery of the person of Jesus or have already committed to following him, this track will help us know him in a deeper way and equip us to grow in our relationship with Jesus.

PEOPLE OF THE WORD

We were created to hear and respond to God's Word. Getting into the Scriptures - and getting them into us - are core activities for Christians. But they are not easy ones. This track will expose us to the big picture of God's Word. It will also introduce us to different forms of bible study and develop us to hear and respond to God through his Word.

KINGDOM LIVING

With the Sermon on the Mount as the foundation, this track will focus on character and conduct. We will help the more mature Christian delve into deeper character issues such as self image, sexuality and family. We will also consider how we as Christians should live out our faith in such areas as politics, multi-ethnicity and social justice.

LIFE AFTER COLLEGE

Discipleship does not end just because we graduate from college. This track is only for juniors, seniors and graduates who would like to explore what it can look like to continue our journey with Christ after we leave college.

GOOD NEWS

To be witnesses on our campus, we first need to let the Gospel story permeate our lives. As this happens our desire for sharing the good news of the gospel deepens. Building upon this foundation this track will provide us with vision, motivation and the necessary tools for us to be faithful and effective witnesses on our campus.

SMALL GROUP VISION

Small groups should be the focal point for what it means to be a witnessing community within InterVarsity. This track will help us to gain a vision of small groups as an authentic biblical community and equip us to lead small groups. It is required for new small group leaders and open to anyone who has a heart for small group ministry.

COORDINATING TEAM (Exec)

What is God's vision for our lives? What is God's vision for our campus? To lead a Christian group we first need to be growing in our own relationship with Christ. This track will focus on the personal growth of the leader as well as seek God's vision and plans for our campus. It will also help us develop our coordinating team into a biblical community.
